

Course Title: **Nuclear Cyber & Information Security Awareness – Part One**

Duration: 3 hours

Target audience:

This course is suitable for all non-technical employers and employees in the nuclear industry and its supply chain, who are seeking to understand more about online security.

Pre-requisites:

There are no formal pre-requisites for this course, however, a general familiarity of windows and browsers may be of benefit.

Aims:

- Identify the main types of cyber security threats
- Understand how to counter those threats
- Understand the implications to both individual and company of not complying with security protocols
- Have the required knowledge to identify what additional training they may need to reduce their own and company's security risk profile

Course outline:

- Putting cyber security into context for the individual
- Identifying the damage to a business that a cyber security attack could cause
- Cyber security attack methods
- Strategies to counter the attacks

Method of training:

This is a highly interactive course where delegates will be encouraged to give their views and learn from each other's experience, as well as the course material presented.
